Balancing Act

2 oz Deep Eddy Lemon Vodka
2 slices fresh jalapeño
2 stems fresh rosemary
Lemonade

Combine vodka, one slice jalapeño and one stem rosemary in a shaker filled with ice. Shake and strain into a Collins glass filled with fresh ice. Top with lemonade. Garnish with remaining jalapeño and rosemary.

Cherry Cola

2 oz Evan Williams Cherry Whiskey
Cola

Add whiskey to a rocks glass filled with ice. Top with cola.

Berry Caipiroska

1 ½ oz Belvedere Vodka
¼ oz simple syrup
3 fresh raspberries
2 small lime wedges

Muddle simple syrup and fruits in the bottom of a rocks glass. Add vodka and a scoop of crushed ice; stir gently. Garnish with additional raspberries if desired.

Raspberry Love

2 oz Bird Dog Kentucky Bourbon
1 oz Chambord Liqueur
6 oz lemon-lime soda
3 fresh raspberries

Combine first two ingredients in a shaker filled with ice. Shake and pour into a tall glass. Top with soda. Garnish with skewered raspberries.

Tequila Flower

½ oz fresh lemon juice
½ tsp superfine sugar
2 oz Cenote Tequila Blanco
½ oz triple sec
1 splash club soda

In a shaker, stir lemon juice and sugar until dissolved. Add ice, tequila and triple sec. Shake and strain into a chilled cocktail glass. Top with club soda.

Sbagliato

4 oz Chandon Brut
1 oz Martini & Rossi Rosso
½ oz Martini & Rossi Bitter Liqueur
Club soda
1 lime wheel

Fill a large wine glass with ice. Add first three ingredients. Top with club soda and gently stir. Garnish with lime wheel.

Bleeding Heart

4 oz Ruffino Prosecco, chilled
½ oz blood orange juice
2 dashes Angostura bitters
1 orange twist

Add first three ingredients to a coupe glass. Swirl to combine and garnish with orange twist.

COCKTAIL OF THE MONTH

BERRY BUBBLY

1 oz Belvedere Vodka
½ oz simple syrup
½ oz fresh lemon juice
2 oz Chandon Rosé
Strawberry slices

Add first three ingredients into a shaker filled with ice; shake. Strain into a cocktail glass. Top with sparkling wine. Garnish with strawberry slices on a skewer.
